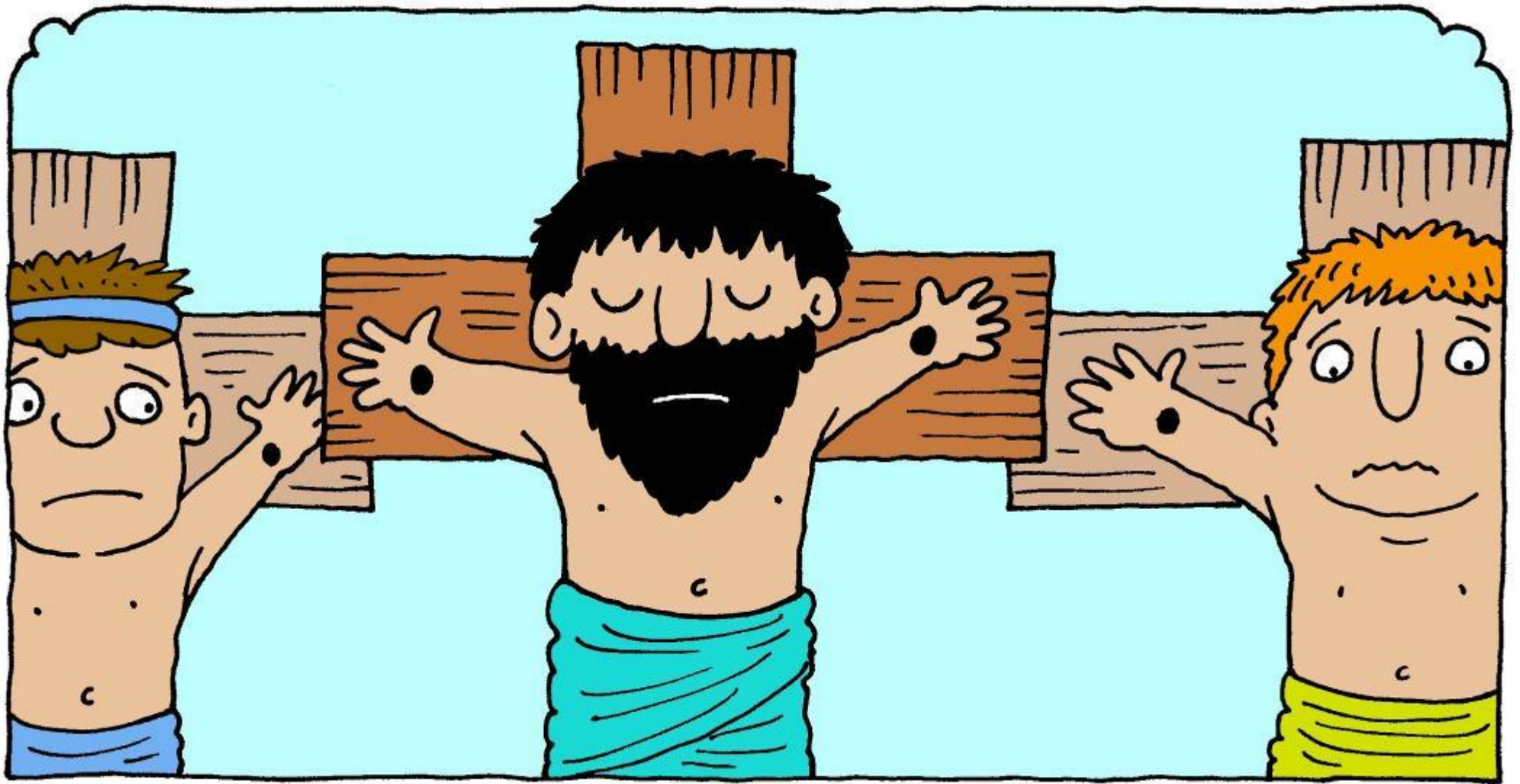
Jesus was sad because he knew that soon he would die on the cross. He took Peter, James and John to the olive orchard in the garden of Gethsemane, to pray.



His friends sat down in the garden while Jesus went a little way off to pray by himself, asking his Heavenly Father to help him face what was about to happen.



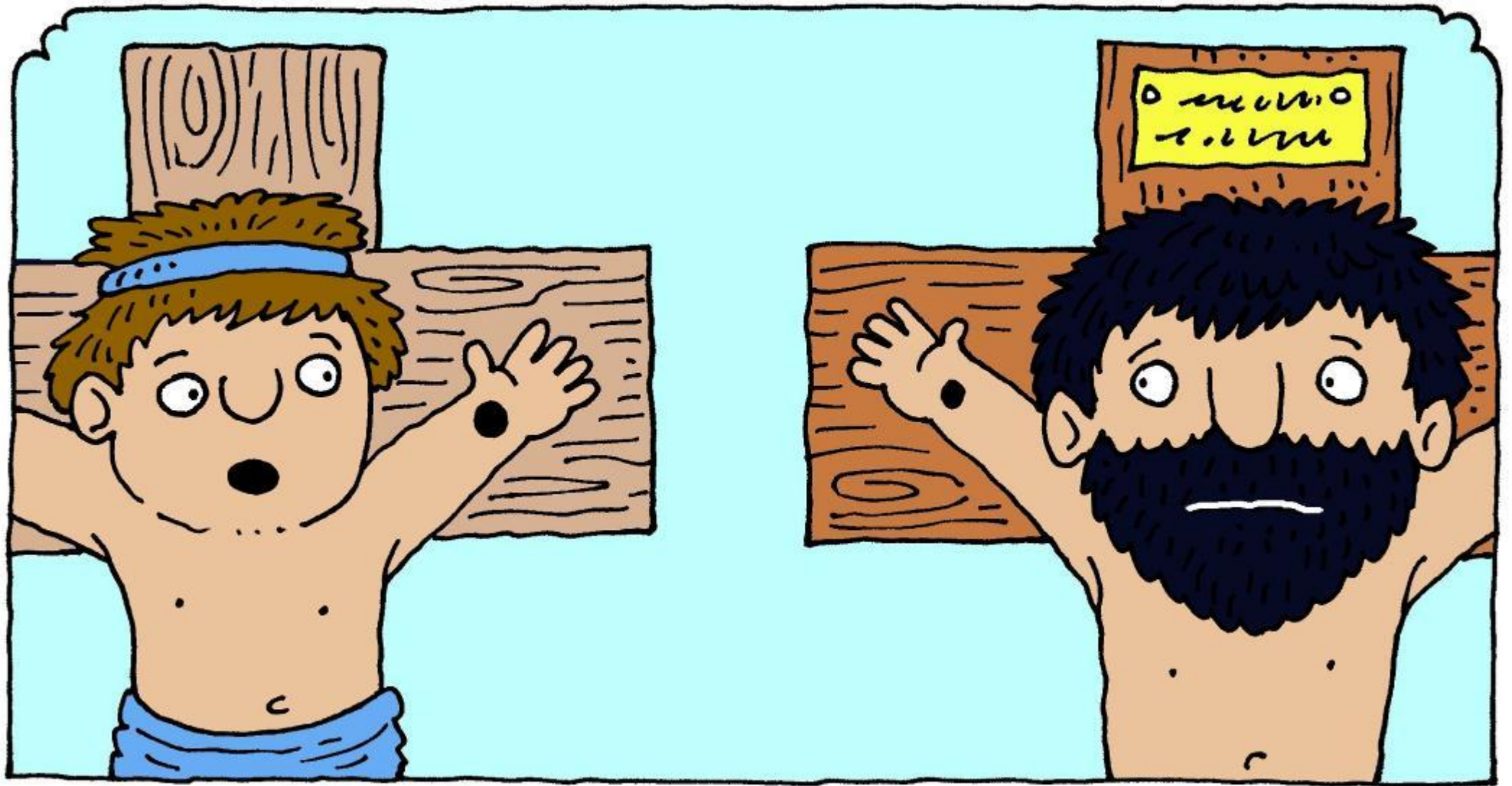
The soldiers came and arrested Jesus.

They decided to put Jesus up on a cross.



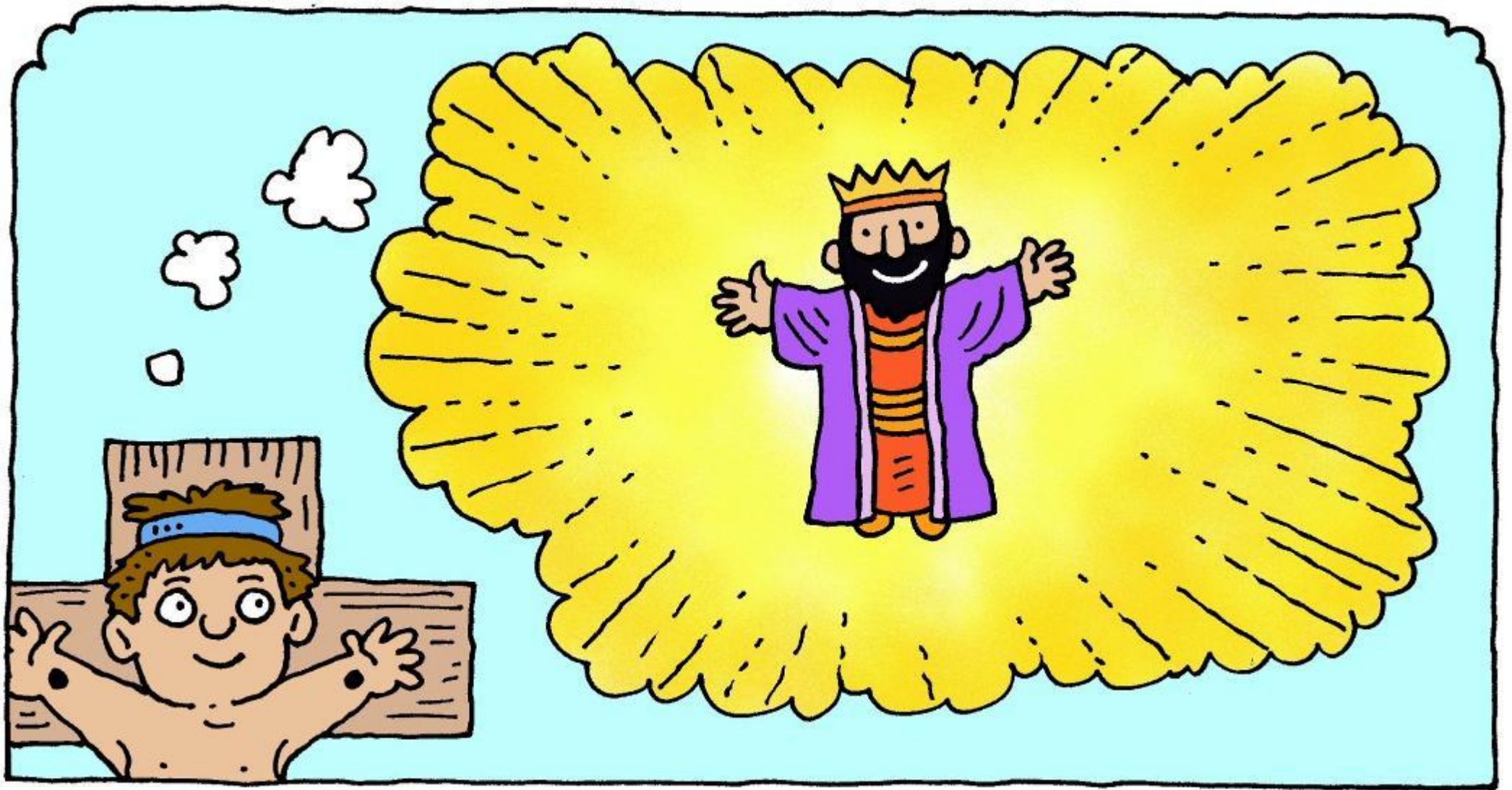
Jesus was crucified on a cross

for stealing other people's things.



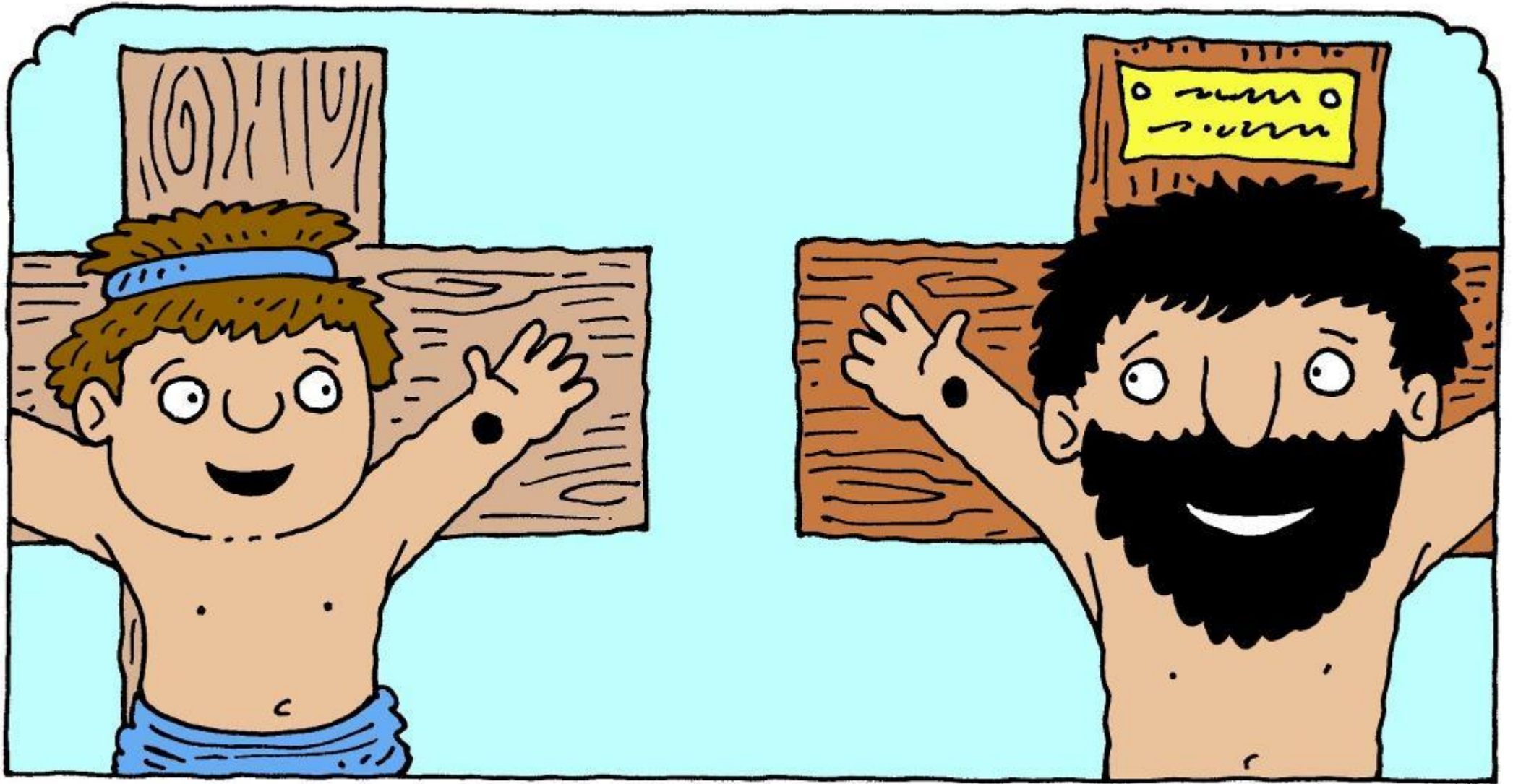
One of the men said “If you really are God’s king,
