Position Description - Music Team Member

Colossians 3:23, 24

Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.

The Music Team make an incredibly important contribution to the work of the Lord at WWEC. Our goal at WWEC is to bring as much glory to God as possible and the Music team make a significant contribution to that by proclaiming God's truths in song. In this ministry, we are servants of God's Word, using music to encourage and build up our church family as we praise God together in song (Col 3:16-17). We always want to lead ourselves and others to sing with heartfelt praise and adoration for the God who has redeemed us. The music team, with their God given musical skills, are not simply playing an instrument or singing, but humbly bringing great honour to God as they lead and love our church family.

Brief Description

Music is a vital part of each service at WWEC. The music team member is responsible for playing an instrument or singing within our Sunday service 'church band', youth group or at other church events. The music team provide the music and lead vocals for the whole of WWEC to sing our praises to God in song. Music team members are Christians committed to Christ and the WWEC family, who aim to use their God given musical skills, to the best of their ability working together as a team to provide the music for the service, serving our church and bringing glory to God.

Detailed description of music ministry

Follow instructions given in the '*Serving Guide - Music*'.

Expectations

- Team members will be part of the team for the year (not limited to that time) and are encouraged to review their participation in this ministry at the end of the calendar year
- Team members will complete the music task on the dates they are assigned on the WWEC Roster. Where unavailable the team member will try to swap with another music team member. When a swap is made;
 - **text your Music Team Leader**
 - forward the reminder SMS received on the Friday (before a Sunday service) to the team member who agreed to swap
- Team members are Christians committed to a Sunday service and Bible study group / youth group [or where a regular Bible study attendance is not possible you are committed to a one to one Bible reading relationship with another mature christian]

- Team members will adhere to WWEC Safe Church policy and agree with the WWEC Volunteer Code of Conduct
- Team members will understand and adhere to the WWEC WH&S procedure for incidents & hazards. If an incident occurs during music an 'Incident form' needs to be completed and provided to the Music Team Leader. If the team member identifies a hazard/near miss during pack up a 'Hazard/Near Miss form' needs to be completed and provided to the Music Team Leader
- Team members will take an interest in praying for other members of their team and church family
- In the event of any issues that arise in the course of serving in this ministry, the team member is to bring them to their team leader. If this is not possible, the team member can bring their concern to a member of the pastoral staff

Accountability

Team Members are to work under, support and accept the authority of Music Team Leader.
